20	Section 15. The sum of \$1,600,000, or so much thereof as
21	may be necessary, is appropriated from the Chicago State
22	University Education Improvement Fund to the Board of
23	Trustees of Chicago State University for any expenses

- 1 incurred by the university.
- 2 Section 20. The sum of \$307,000, or so much thereof as
- 3 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General
- 4 Professions Dedicated Fund to the Board of Trustees of
- 5 Chicago State University for costs associated with the
- 6 development, support or administration of pharmacy practice
- 7 education or training programs.
- 8 ARTICLE 99
- Section 99. Effective Date. This Act takes effect July 9
- 1, 2014.". 10
