- Section 10. The sum of \$350,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Underground Utility Facilities Damage Prevention Fund to the Illinois Commerce Commission for a grant to the Statewide One-call Notice System, as required in the Illinois Underground Utility Facilities Damage Prevention Act.
- Section 15. The sum of \$1,000, or so much thereof as may
 be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Underground
 Utility Facilities Damage Prevention Fund to the Illinois
 Commerce Commission for refunds.
- Section 20. The sum of \$77,130,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Wireless Service Emergency Fund to the Illinois Commerce Commission

Section 35. The sum of \$4,240,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Transportation Regulatory Fund to the Illinois Commerce Commission for (1) disbursing funds collected for the Single State Insurance Registration Program and/or Unified Carrier Registration (2) for refunds for overpayments; and (3) for administrative expenses.

Section 40. The sum of \$5,500,000, or so much of thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Illinois Commerce Commission from the Wireless Carrier Reimbursement Fund for deposit into the Public Utility Fund.
