2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 6132, by deleting
3 everything after the enacting clause and inserting the
4 following:

5 "ARTICLE 1

19 Section 30. The sum of \$312,227, or so much thereof as
 20 may be necessary and remains unexpended at the close of
 21 business on June 30, 2014, from appropriations heretofore
 22 made for such purpose in Article 23, Sections 30 and 35 of
 23 Public Act 98-0064, is reappropriated from the Illinois

1 Historic Sites Fund to the Historic Preservation Agency for
 2 awards and grants for historic preservation programs made
 3 either independently or in cooperation with the Federal
 4 Government or any agency thereof, any municipal corporation,
 5 or political subdivision of the State, or with any public or
 6 private corporation, organization, or individual.

7 Section 35. The sum of \$150,000, or so much thereof as
 8 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Historic Property
 9 Administrative Fund to the Historic Preservation Agency for
 10 administrative expenses associated with the Historic Tax
 11 Credit Program.

12 Section 40. The following named sums, or so much thereof
 13 as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects and
 14 purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated to meet the
 15 ordinary and contingent expenses of the Historic Preservation
 16 Agency:

10 to Union Station, the Old State Capitol and the Old Journal
11 Register Building.

12 Section 50. The following named sums, or so much thereof

14 purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated to meet the
15 ordinary and contingent expenses of the Historic Preservation
16 Agency:

 19 donations are received at Illinois State Historic Sites.

17 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
18 Fund to the Historic Preservation Agency for a grant to the
19 DuSable Museum of African American History for costs
20 associated with the Amistad Commission of Illinois.
