1 HOUSE RESOLUTION 370

- 2 WHEREAS, It has come to the attention of the Illinois House 3 of Representatives that, on average, 22 veterans commit suicide 4 every day; this constitutes a very serious problem in every 5 state, including Illinois; and
- WHEREAS, Those individuals have fought in recent conflicts
  under very demanding and dangerous circumstances; and
- 8 WHEREAS, For many veterans, their re-entry into a stable 9 and productive civilian life has caused unexpected mental and 10 emotional problems, resulting in Post-Traumatic Stress 11 Disorder (PTSD) and other severe mental illnesses; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Medications are now available to mitigate the 13 severity of those mental illnesses; and
- 14 WHEREAS, The State of Illinois has an obligation to provide 15 its veterans the opportunity to acquire such medications; 16 therefore, be it
- RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
  NINETY-EIGHTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that
  we urge the Department of Healthcare and Family Services to
  develop a basic protocol which will provide direction on how

- 1 best to make available such medications to veterans suffering
- from PTSD and other forms of severe mental illness, such as
- 3 schizophrenia, schizophrenia disorder, and bipolar disorders;
- 4 and be it further

5 RESOLVED, That the chair and the minority spokesman of the Veterans' 6 Affairs Committee shall monitor the 7 preparations of such protocol and periodically make reports to the House of Representatives, the Office of the Governor, the 8 9 director of the Department of Healthcare and Family Services, and the director of the Department of Veterans' Affairs not 10 11 later than March 1, 2014.
