Guyse at Greater St. John Baptist Church in Markham; after serving for 2 years as interim Pastor of Second Baptist Church, he served for 10 years as Assistant Pastor of First Paradise M.B. Church in Chicago under the late Pastor Eddie H. Gardner, Sr.; at the age of 33, he was chosen to serve as pastor of Woodlawn Union Baptist Church in Chicago; under Pastor Moore's leadership, the church's membership increased from 25 to 200 members in less than 2 years; and
