## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Mental Health and Developmental
- 5 Disabilities Administrative Act is amended by changing Section
- 6 18.3 as follows:
- 7 (20 ILCS 1705/18.3)
- 8 Sec. 18.3. Integrated system for services for the mentally
- 9 ill. The Department shall develop an effective, integrated
- 10 system for delivering State-funded and State-operated services
- 11 to persons with mental illness. No later than June 30, 1994,
- 12 the Department shall enter into one or more cooperative
- arrangements with the Department of Public Aid, the Department
- of Rehabilitation Services, the Department of Public Health,
- and any other appropriate entities for administration or
- 16 supervision by the Department of Mental Health and
- 17 Developmental Disabilities of all State programs for services
- to persons in community care facilities for persons with mental
- 19 illness, including but not limited to intermediate care
- 20 facilities, that are supported by State funds or by funding
- 21 under Title XIX of the federal Social Security Act. The
- 22 Department shall form a medical advisory panel, appointed by
- 23 the Secretary, comprised of 5 physicians licensed to practice

medicine in all its branches with a special emphasis in

- 2 treating mental illness, to provide advice on care rendered to
- patients in any integrated delivery system. The Department of 3
- Human Services shall succeed to the responsibilities of the
- 5 Department of Mental Health and Developmental Disabilities and
- 6 the Department of Rehabilitation Services under any such
- 7 cooperative arrangement in existence on July 1, 1997.
