AN ACT concerning State government.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Secretary of State Merit Employment Code is
amended by changing Section 12 as follows:

6 (15 ILCS 310/12) (from Ch. 124, par. 112)

7 Sec. 12. Employees of the Office of the Secretary of State - election to public office - leave of absence - re-entry of 8 9 service. Any person holding a position in the Office of the Secretary of State, who is elected to public office, may shall, 10 upon request, be granted a leave of absence, without pay, from 11 such position. The leave of absence shall continue so long as 12 he remains an elected officer or for a period of 5 years, 13 14 whichever is shorter and for a period of 30 calendar days thereafter. 15

16 If such person files a written request with the Director of 17 Personnel to re-enter active service with the Office of the 18 Secretary of State within <u>a 30-day period following the</u> 19 <u>termination of his leave</u>, such 30 day period he <u>may shall</u> be 20 reinstated to his former position or a position of comparable 21 duties, responsibilities and pay.
