

1 AN ACT concerning transportation.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by changing
5 Section 13-111 as follows:

6 (625 ILCS 5/13-111) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 13-111)

7 Sec. 13-111. Operation without certificate of safety
8 attached; Effective date of certificate.

9 (a) Except as provided for in Chapter 13, no person shall
10 operate any vehicle required to be inspected by this Chapter
11 upon the highways of this State unless there is affixed to that
12 vehicle a certificate of safety then in effect. The Secretary
13 of State, State Police, and other police officers shall enforce
14 this Section. The Department shall determine the expiration
15 date of the certificate of safety.

16 The certificates, all forms and records, reports of tests
17 and retests, and the full procedure and methods of making the
18 tests and retests, shall be in the form prescribed by the
19 Department.

20 (b) Every person convicted of violating this Section is
21 guilty of a petty offense with a minimum fine of \$95 and a
22 maximum fine of \$250; unless the violation is contemporaneous
23 with a motor vehicle accident, in which case the person is

1 guilty of a Class C misdemeanor.
