- AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 1294 1 2 AMENDMENT NO. . Amend Senate Bill 1294, AS AMENDED, 3 by replacing everything after the enacting clause with the 4 following: "Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by 5 6 changing Section 13-111 as follows: 7 (625 ILCS 5/13-111) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 13-111) Sec. 13-111. Operation without certificate of safety 8 attached; Effective date of certificate. 9 (a) Except as provided for in Chapter 13, no person shall 10 operate any vehicle required to be inspected by this Chapter
- operate any vehicle required to be inspected by this Chapter upon the highways of this State unless there is affixed to that vehicle a certificate of safety then in effect. The Secretary of State, State Police, and other police officers shall enforce this Section. The Department shall determine the expiration date of the certificate of safety.

- The certificates, all forms and records, reports of tests 1
- 2 and retests, and the full procedure and methods of making the
- 3 tests and retests, shall be in the form prescribed by the
- 4 Department.
- 5 (b) Every person convicted of violating this Section is
- 6 quilty of a petty offense with a minimum fine of \$95 and a
- maximum fine of \$250; unless the violation is contemporaneous 7
- with a motor vehicle accident, in which case the person is 8
- 9 guilty of a Class C misdemeanor.
