2	AMENDMENT NO Amend Senate Bill 1523 by replacing
3	everything after the enacting clause with the following:
4	"Section 5. The Illinois Pension Code is amended by
5	changing Sections 17-137, 17-138, and 17-139 as follows:
6	(40 ILCS 5/17-137) (from Ch. 108 1/2, par. 17-137)
7	Sec. 17-137. Board created. There shall be elected a Board
8	of Trustees, herein also referred to as the "Board", to
9	administer and control the Fund created by this Article. The
10	Board shall consist of 12 members, 2 of whom shall be members
11	of the Board of Education, 6 of whom shall be contributors who
12	are not <u>administrators</u> principals, one of whom shall be a
13	contributor who is <u>an administrator</u> a principal, and 3 of whom
14	shall be pensioners, all to be chosen as provided in this
15	Article.

(40 ILCS 5/17-138) (from Ch. 108 1/2, par. 17-138) 1 Sec. 17-138. Board membership. At the first meeting of the 2 3 Board of Education in November of each year, the Board of 4 Education shall appoint one of its members to serve, while a 5 member of the Board of Education, on the Board of Trustees for 6 a term of 2 years. During the first week of November, On the last school day 7 8 of the 4th week of October of each year there shall be elected 9 2 members of the Board from the teachers other than 10 administrators principals, who shall hold office for terms of 3 years, provided the trustee retains his or her while retaining 11 12 their status as a teacher teachers other than an administrator 13 principals, and other members to fill any unexpired terms. In 14 the event that schools are not in session on or during the week prior to the last Friday in October, this election shall be 15 16 held on the Friday of the first subsequent full week of school. 17 The election shall be by secret ballot conducted in person or 18 by secure electronic ballot, and shall be held in such manner 19 as the Board by bylaws or rules shall provide. Only teachers 20 who are not administrators principals shall be eligible to vote in the election. 21

During the first week of November of 1995 and every third year thereafter, one contributor who is <u>an administrator</u> a principal shall be elected a member of the Board. This trustee shall hold office for a term of 3 years, provided the trustee 09800SB1523ham001 -3- LRB098 07986 EFG 46321 a

1 retains while retaining his or her status as an administrator a principal. The election shall be by mail ballot or by secure 2 3 electronic ballot, and only contributors who are 4 administrators principals shall be eligible to vote. The 5 election shall be held in the manner provided by the Board by 6 rule or bylaw.

During the first week of November of each odd-numbered year there shall be elected 3 members of the Board from the pensioners, who shall hold office for a term of 2 years while retaining their status as pensioners. The election shall be by mail ballot <u>or secure electronic ballot</u> to all service and disability pensioners, and shall be held in such manner as the Board by bylaws or rules shall provide.

All trustees, while members of the Board of Education or 14 15 administrators principals, teachers while other than 16 administrators principals, or pensioners, as the case may be, shall hold their offices until their successors shall have been 17 appointed or elected and qualified by subscribing to the 18 constitutional oath of office at the immediately succeeding 19 20 regular meeting of the Board.

24 (1) Contributors other than <u>administrators</u> principals
25 election. Every member who is not a principal or an

administrator may vote at the election for as many persons as 1 there are trustees to be elected by the contributors who are 2 3 not principals or administrators, provided that the 4 contributor obtained that voter eligibility status on or before 5 October 1 of the election year. The name of a candidate shall not be placed on printed upon the ballot unless he or she has 6 been assigned on a regular certificate for at least 10 years in 7 8 the Chicago public schools or charter schools and nominated by 9 a petition signed by not less than 200 contributors who are not 10 principals or administrators.

11 Petitions shall be filed with the recording secretary of the Fund on or after September 15 of each year and not later 12 13 than October 1st of that year. No more than one candidate may 14 be nominated by any one petition. If the nominations do not 15 exceed the number of candidates to be elected, the canvassing 16 shall declare the nominated candidates board elected. 17 Otherwise, candidates receiving the highest number of votes 18 cast for their respective terms shall be declared elected. The 19 location and number of polling places shall be designated by 20 the Board. The election shall be conducted by the teachers who 21 are not principals or administrators, and the judges of the 22 election shall be selected from the teachers who are not principals or administrators, in such manner as the board in 23 24 its bylaws or rules provides.

1 (2) Pensioners election. The name of a candidate shall not be placed printed on the ballot unless he or she has been 2 3 nominated by a petition signed by not less than 100 pensioners 4 of the Fund. Petitions shall be filed with the recording 5 secretary of the Fund on or before October 1 of the odd-numbered year. If the nominations do not exceed 3, the 6 mailing of ballots shall be eliminated and the nominated 7 candidates shall be declared elected. Otherwise, the 8 3 9 candidates receiving the highest number of votes cast shall be 10 declared elected. The mailing and counting of the ballots shall be conducted by the office of the Fund with volunteer 11 12 assistance from pensioners at the request of the Board.

13 (3) Administrators Principals election. The name of a candidate shall not be placed printed on the ballot unless he 14 15 or she has been nominated by a petition signed by at least 25 16 contributors who are principals or administrators. Petitions 17 shall be filed with the recording secretary of the Fund on or 18 before October 1 of the election year. Every member who is a 19 principal or an administrator may vote at the election for one 20 candidate who is a contributor who is an administrator, 21 provided that the member obtained such voter eligibility status 22 on or before October 1 of the election year a principal. If 23 only one eligible candidate is nominated, the election shall 24 not be held and the nominated candidate shall be declared 25 elected. Otherwise, the candidate receiving the highest number 26 of votes cast shall be declared elected. The mailing and

1 counting of the ballots shall be conducted by the office of the 2 Fund.

3 (4) Vacancies. The Board may fill vacancies occurring in 4 the membership of the Board elected by the principals, 5 administrators, teachers other than principals or 6 administrators, or pensioners at any regular meeting of the 7 Board. The Board of Education may fill vacancies occurring in the membership of the Board appointed by the Board of Education 8 9 at any regular meeting of the Board of Education.
