

98TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2013 and 2014 SB1861

Introduced 2/15/2013, by Sen. Mike Jacobs

SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

20 ILCS 2610/7.3 new 20 ILCS 415/4c

from Ch. 127, par. 63b104c

Amends the State Police Act and the Personnel Code. Provides that the State Police Merit Board may hire employees as may be necessary and appropriate to carry out its duties and responsibilities. Provides that employees of the Merit Board shall not be subject to the Personnel Code. Provides that the Board shall fix the salaries of its employees. Provides that the Board shall adopt rules establishing a general salary schedule according to a classification of employees, but subject to merit increases, which shall apply to all employees. Provides that the Board may suspend or dismiss employees as necessary. Provides that the Board shall adopt rules establishing grounds for dismissal of employees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 6 (1) All officers elected by the people.
- 7 (2) All positions under the Lieutenant Governor,
 8 Secretary of State, State Treasurer, State Comptroller,
 9 State Board of Education, Clerk of the Supreme Court,
 10 Attorney General, and State Board of Elections.
 - (3) Judges, and officers and employees of the courts, and notaries public.
 - (4) All officers and employees of the Illinois General Assembly, all employees of legislative commissions, all officers and employees of the Illinois Legislative Reference Bureau, the Legislative Research Unit, and the Legislative Printing Unit.
 - (5) All positions in the Illinois National Guard and Illinois State Guard, paid from federal funds or positions in the State Military Service filled by enlistment and paid from State funds.
 - (6) All employees of the Governor at the executive mansion and on his immediate personal staff.
 - (7) Directors of Departments, the Adjutant General, the Assistant Adjutant General, the Director of the Illinois Emergency Management Agency, members of boards

and commissions, and all other positions appointed by the Governor by and with the consent of the Senate.

- The presidents, other principal administrative officers, and teaching, research and extension faculties of Chicago State University, Eastern Illinois University, Governors State University, Illinois State University, Northeastern Illinois University, Northern Illinois University, Western Illinois University, the Illinois Community College Board, Southern Illinois University, Illinois Board of Higher Education, University of Illinois, State Universities Civil Service University Retirement System of Illinois, and administrative officers and scientific and technical staff of the Illinois State Museum.
- (9) All other employees except the presidents, other principal administrative officers, and teaching, research and extension faculties of the universities under the jurisdiction of the Board of Regents and the colleges and universities under the jurisdiction of the Board of Governors of State Colleges and Universities, Illinois Community College Board, Southern Illinois University, Illinois Board of Higher Education, Board of Governors of State Colleges and Universities, the Board of Regents, University of Illinois, State Universities Civil Service System, University Retirement System of Illinois, so long as these are subject to the provisions of the State

- 1 Universities Civil Service Act.
- 2 (10) The State Police so long as they are subject to 3 the merit provisions of the State Police Act.

(10.1) Employees of the State Police Merit Board.

 - (12) The technical and engineering staffs of the Department of Transportation, the Department of Nuclear Safety, the Pollution Control Board, and the Illinois Commerce Commission, and the technical and engineering staff providing architectural and engineering services in the Department of Central Management Services.
- (13) All employees of the Illinois State Toll Highway Authority.
 - (14) The Secretary of the Illinois Workers' Compensation Commission.
 - (15) All persons who are appointed or employed by the Director of Insurance under authority of Section 202 of the Illinois Insurance Code to assist the Director of Insurance in discharging his responsibilities relating to the rehabilitation, liquidation, conservation, and dissolution of companies that are subject to the jurisdiction of the Illinois Insurance Code.
 - (16) All employees of the St. Louis Metropolitan Area Airport Authority.
 - (17) All investment officers employed by the Illinois State Board of Investment.

- (19) Seasonal employees of the Department of Agriculture for the operation of the Illinois State Fair and the DuQuoin State Fair, no one person receiving more than 29 days of such employment in any calendar year.
- (20) All "temporary" employees hired under the Department of Natural Resources' Illinois Conservation Service, a youth employment program that hires young people to work in State parks for a period of one year or less.
- (21) All hearing officers of the Human Rights Commission.
- (22) All employees of the Illinois Mathematics and Science Academy.
- (23) All employees of the Kankakee River Valley Area Airport Authority.
- (24) The commissioners and employees of the Executive Ethics Commission.
- (25) The Executive Inspectors General, including special Executive Inspectors General, and employees of each Office of an Executive Inspector General.
- 25 (26) The commissioners and employees of the Legislative Ethics Commission.
