

1 AN ACT concerning finance.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 1. Short title. This Act may be cited as the Grant
5 Information Collection Act.

6 Section 5. Definitions. For the purposes of this Act,
7 unless the context otherwise requires:

8 "Grant funds" means any public funds dispensed by a grantor
9 agency to any person or entity for obligation, expenditure, or
10 use by that person or entity for a specific purpose or purposes
11 and any funds disbursed by the State Comptroller pursuant to an
12 appropriation made by the General Assembly to a named entity or
13 person. Funds disbursed in accordance with a fee for service
14 purchase of care contract are not grant funds for purposes of
15 this Act.

16 Neither the method by which funds are dispensed, whether by
17 contract, agreement, grant subsidy, letter of credit, or any
18 other method, nor the purpose for which the funds are used can
19 change the character of funds which otherwise would be
20 considered grant funds as defined in this Section.

21 "Grantee" means the person or entity which may use grant
22 funds.

23 "Grantor agency" means a State agency that dispenses grant

1 funds.

2 "State agency" means State-supported universities and
3 colleges and any department, office, commission, board, or
4 authority within the Executive Department, other than the
5 Office of the Lieutenant Governor, the Office of the Attorney
6 General, the Office of the Secretary of State, the Office of
7 the Comptroller, or the Office of the Treasurer.

8 Section 10. Grant information collection. The Chief
9 Information Officer of the State, as designated by the
10 Governor, shall coordinate with each State agency to develop,
11 with any existing or newly available resources and technology,
12 appropriate systems to accurately report data containing
13 financial information. These systems shall include a module
14 that is specific to the management and administration of grant
15 funds.

16 Each grantor agency that is authorized to award grant funds
17 to an entity other than the State of Illinois shall coordinate
18 with the Chief Information Officer of the State to provide for
19 the publication, at data.illinois.gov or any other publicly
20 accessible website designated by the Chief Information
21 Officer, of data sets containing information regarding awards
22 of grant funds that the grantor agency has made during the
23 previous fiscal year. Data sets shall be published on at least
24 a quarterly basis and shall include, at a minimum, the
25 following:

- 1 (1) the name of the grantor agency;
- 2 (2) the name and postal zip code of the grantee;
- 3 (3) a short description of the purpose of the award of
- 4 grant funds;
- 5 (4) the amount of each award of grant funds;
- 6 (5) the date of each award of grant funds; and
- 7 (6) the duration of each award of grant funds.

8 In addition, each grantor agency shall make best efforts,
9 with available resources and technology, to make available in
10 the data sets any other data that is relevant to its award of
11 grant funds.

12 Data not subject to the requirements of this Section
13 include data to which a State agency may deny access pursuant
14 to any provision of a federal, State, or local law, rule, or
15 regulation.
