Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 90. The sum of \$740,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Department of State Police, Division of Internal Investigation, from the General Revenue Fund for the ordinary and contingent expenses incurred while operating the Nursing Home Identified Offender Program.
- Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1, 2013.
