1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 2809 2 AMENDMENT NO. . Amend Senate Bill 2809, AS AMENDED, 3 by replacing everything after the enacting clause with the following: 4 "Section 5. The Illinois Pension Code is amended by 5 6 changing Section 1-115 as follows: 7 (40 ILCS 5/1-115) (from Ch. 108 1/2, par. 1-115) Sec. 1-115. Civil Enforcement. A civil action may be 8 brought by the Attorney General or by a participant, 9 10 beneficiary or fiduciary in order to: (a) Obtain appropriate relief under Section 1-114 of this 11 12 Code; 13 (b) Enjoin any act or practice which violates any provision of this Code; or

(c) Obtain other appropriate equitable relief to redress

any such violation or to enforce any such provision.

1	Notwithstanding any other provision of the Administrative
2	Review Law or this Code to the contrary, a civil action may be
3	brought by the Attorney General to enjoin the payment of
4	benefits under this Code to any person who is convicted of any
5	felony relating to or arising out of or in connection with that
6	person's service as an employee under this Code.
