

## 98TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2013 and 2014 SB3096

## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

625 ILCS 5/7-307

from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 7-307

Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Provides that a judgment creditor or his or her attorney, in addition to the clerk of a court or the judge of a court which has no clerk, shall forward a certified report of any judgment for damages, the rendering and nonpayment of which required the suspension of the driver's license and registration, to the Secretary of State. Effective immediately.

1 AN ACT concerning transportation.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by changing Section 7-307 as follows:
- 6 (625 ILCS 5/7-307) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 7-307)
- 7 Sec. 7-307. Courts to report nonpayments of judgment. The 8 clerk of a court, or the judge of a court which has no clerk, or 9 the judgment creditor or his or her attorney of record shall forward to the Secretary of State, on a form prescribed by the 10 Secretary, a certified record of any judgment for damages, the 11 rendering and nonpayment of which judgment required the 12 suspension of the driver's license and registrations in the 13 14 name of the judgment debtor hereunder, such record to be forwarded to the Secretary of State upon request by the 15 16 plaintiff after the expiration of 30 days after such judgment 17 has become final and when such judgment has not been stayed or satisfied within the amounts specified in this Article as shown 18 19 by the records of the Court.
