SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Amends the Illinois Holocaust and Genocide Commission Act. Provides that the President and Minority Leader of the Senate shall each designate a member or former member of the Senate and the Speaker and Minority Leader of the House of Representatives shall each designate a member or former member of the House of Representatives to advise the Commission. Provides that upon the expiration of the terms of the initial members, the appointing authority may re-appoint initial members and sets forth the terms of those re-appointments. Provides that a representative under the Act must be an officer or employee of the State agency that employs the ex officio member or an individual with demonstrated expertise in the subject matter of the ex officio member's State agency. Effective immediately.

4 (a) An ex officio member of the Commission vacates the 5 person's position on the Commission if the person ceases to 6 hold the position that qualifies the person for service on the 7 Commission.

years, except that the terms of the initial members shall

1 <u>(3) five members to terms that expire February 1, 2018.</u> 2 <u>Notwithstanding subsection (c) of this Section, initial</u> 3 <u>members re-appointed to terms that expire on February 1, 2016</u> 4 <u>or February 1, 2017 may be appointed to a 4-year term following</u> 5 <u>expiration of their re-appointment.</u>

6 (b) A public member is eligible for reappointment to 7 another term or part of a term.

8 (c) A public member may not serve more than 2 consecutive 9 <u>full</u> terms. For purposes of this prohibition, a member is 10 considered to have served a <u>full</u> term only if the member has 11 served more than half of <u>a 4-year</u> the term.
