| 9 | (a) The Commission is composed of $\underline{21}$ $\underline{18}$ members as follows: |
| 10 | (1) $\underline{18}$ $\underline{15}$ public members appointed by the Governor; and |
| 11 | (2) 3 ex officio members as follows: |
| 12 | (A) the State Superintendent of Education; |
| 13 | (B) the Executive Director of the Board of Higher |
| 14 | Education; and |
| 15 | (C) the Director of Veterans' Affairs. |
| 16 | (b) The President and Minority Leader of the Senate shall |

- each designate a member or former member of the Senate and the
- 2 Speaker and Minority Leader of the House of Representatives
- 3 shall each designate a member or former member of the House of
- 4 Representatives to advise the Commission.

- 8 Sec. 20. Ex officio members; eligibility; designation of

- 10 (a) An ex officio member of the Commission vacates the
- 11 person's position on the Commission if the person ceases to
- 12 hold the position that qualifies the person for service on the
- 13 Commission.
- 14 (b) An ex officio member may designate a representative to
- 15 serve on the Commission in the member's absence. A
- 16 representative designated under this subsection must be an
- officer or employee of the State agency that employs the ex
- 18 officio member or an individual with demonstrated expertise in
- 19 the subject matter of the ex officio member's State agency.

- Sec. 30. Term of public member.
- 24 (a) A public member of the Commission serves a term of 4

- 1 years, except that the terms of the initial members shall
- expire on February 1, 2015. Following the expiration of the 2
- terms of the initial members of the Commission, the Governor 3
- 4 may re-appoint initial members as follows:
- 5 (1) five members to terms that expire February 1, 2016;
- 6 (2) five members to terms that expire February 1, 2017;
- 7 and
- (3) five members to terms that expire February 1, 2018. 8
- 9 Notwithstanding subsection (c) of this Section, initial
- 10 members re-appointed to terms that expire on February 1, 2016
- 11 or February 1, 2017 may be appointed to a 4-year term following
- expiration of their re-appointment. 12
- 13 (a-5) Public members of the Commission added under this
- 14 amendatory Act of the 98th General Assembly shall serve 4-year
- 15 terms.
- 16 (b) A public member is eligible for reappointment to
- 17 another term or part of a term.
- (c) A public member may not serve more than 2 consecutive 18
- <u>full</u> terms. For purposes of this prohibition, a member is 19
- 20 considered to have served a full term only if the member has
- served more than half of a 4-year the term. 21
