### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

415 ILCS 60/3

Amends the Illinois Pesticide Act. Provides that the regulation of pesticides by any political subdivision of this State, including home rule units, is specifically prohibited except for counties with a population over 2,000,000 and municipalities entirely within Cook County with a population over 50,000.

# 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Illinois Pesticide Act is amended by 5 changing Section 3 as follows:

6 (415 ILCS 60/3) (from Ch. 5, par. 803)

Sec. 3. Delegation of Authority. The Illinois Department of
Agriculture shall administer "The Illinois Pesticide Act".

9 1. It shall be the duty of the Department of Agriculture to enforce this Act and such provisions of other Acts intended to 10 control the registration, purchase, use, storage and disposal 11 of pesticides, unless otherwise specified in this Section. 12 13 Also, the Department of Agriculture shall control the purchase 14 and use of pesticides pertaining to the production, protection, care, storage, or transportation of agricultural commodities 15 16 and to control the use of pesticides applied by agricultural 17 equipment. Also, the Department shall establish and implement an Agrichemical Facility Response Action Program as provided in 18 19 Section 19.3.

20 2. It shall be the duty of the Department of Public Health 21 to enforce such provisions of this Act and other Acts intended 22 to control structural pest pesticides, as defined in 23 subparagraph 37 of Section 4, of this Act. It shall be the duty of the Department of Public Health to enforce such provisions of this Act related to vector control, control of pestiferous and disease carrying insects, rodents and other animals, and control of birds and other mammals that may pose a threat to the health of the public.

3. It shall be the duty of the Environmental Protection
Agency to enforce such provisions of this Act and other Acts
intended to protect and preserve the quality of air, water, and
guard against unreasonable contamination of land resources.

10 4. The regulation of pesticides by any political 11 subdivision of this State, including home rule units, is 12 specifically prohibited except for counties and municipalities 13 with a population over 2,000,000 and municipalities entirely 14 within Cook County with a population over 50,000. The 15 regulation of pesticides under this Act is an exclusive power 16 and function of the State, except as provided in this 17 paragraph, and is a denial and limitation, under Article VII, Section 6, subsection (h) of the Illinois Constitution, of the 18 power of a home rule unit to regulate pesticides. 19
