Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 70. The amount of \$550,000, or so much thereof as
 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Private Business
 and Vocational Schools Quality Assurance Fund to the Board of
 Higher Education as supplemental support for costs and
 expenses associated with the administration and enforcement
 of the Private Business and Vocational Schools Act of 2012.
- Section 75. The sum of \$5,500,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the BHE Federal Grants

 Fund to the Board of Higher Education to be expended under the terms and conditions associated with the federal contracts and grants moneys received.
- Section 80. The following named amounts, or so much thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated from the
