1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

ARTICLE 1 4 Section 1. The following named amounts, or so much 5 6 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects 7 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated to the Board of the Trustees of Chicago State University to meet ordinary 8 9 and contingent expenses for the fiscal year ending June 30, 10 2015: Payable from the Education Assistance Fund: 11 12 For Personal Services, including payment 13 to the university for personal services 14 costs incurred during the fiscal year and salaries accrued but unpaid to academic 15 16 personnel for personal services rendered 17 For State Contributions to Social 18 Security, for Medicare 19 20 21

- Section 5. The sum of \$0, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Professions

- Section 10. The sum of \$1,600,000, or so much thereof as
 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Chicago State
 University Education Improvement Fund to the Board of
 Trustees of Chicago State University for any expenses
 incurred by the university.
- 19 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1, 20 2014.
