WHEREAS, Metra currently runs 11 separate lines, each of

- 1 which terminates in downtown Chicago; these lines do not travel
- through downtown Chicago, which would be far more efficient; 2
- 3 and
- 4 WHEREAS, Union Station has 2 tracks that travel through the
- 5 station that are not currently used, but could be used for
- 6 Metra or Amtrak service; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Northeast Illinois has long suffered from a
- 8 jobs-housing mismatch, where tens of thousands of entry-level
- 9 jobs in and around O'Hare airport and the northwest suburbs
- struggle to be filled, while tens of thousands of residents of 10
- the south side and south suburbs struggle to find employment; 11
- 12 and
- 13 WHEREAS, Current public transportation between the south
- suburbs and the south side of Chicago and the northwest suburbs 14
- 15 is a long, laborious journey involving transfers between buses
- 16 and rail, creating a greater barrier to full employment in the
- 17 region; and
- WHEREAS, This initiative is consistent with the long-term 18
- 19 vision for northeastern Illinois set forth by the Chicago
- Metropolitan Agency for Planning; and 20
- 21 WHEREAS, Crossrail Chicago could connect Rockford, Elgin,

- 1 Hoffman Estates, Schaumburg, Arlington Heights, and O'Hare
- through Union Station to McCormick Place, Hyde Park, Homewood,
- 3 University Park, the south suburban airport, Kankakee, and
- 4 Champaign-Urbana in one electrified track; and
- 5 WHEREAS, There is an opportunity to build a new train
- 6 station at O'Hare Airport as part of the consolidated rental
- 7 car facility currently out for bid that can connect to the
- 8 extended people-mover and existing Metra service on the North
- 9 Central District line; and
- 10 WHEREAS, The new electrified line of Crossrail Chicago
- 11 would be located largely on publicly-owned rights-of-way and
- 12 could bring tremendous economic benefits to the region and
- 13 State; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Crossrail Chicago would allow for a direct train
- 15 ride between O'Hare Airport and McCormick Place, the
- 16 continent's largest convention facility; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Metra service along the Metra Electric line from
- 18 University Park to McCormick Place could be significantly
- improved through the Crossrail Chicago initiative; and
- 20 WHEREAS, Using existing elevated tracks along 16th Street
- 21 could connect Metra Electric tracks, Metra Rock Island tracks,

- 1 and Union Station; and
- 2 WHEREAS, Crossrail Chicago can also serve as the trunk of a
- 3 Midwest high-speed rail network, which would bring millions of
- 4 people together into one stronger economic unit; therefore, be

- 6 RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-EIGHTH GENERAL
- 7 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we urge the Chicago
