1 SENATE RESOLUTION WHEREAS, Almost one in 10 U.S. counties has a population 2 that consists of more than 50% minorities; and 3 WHEREAS, Only 6% of the national public school teaching 4 5 force is Hispanic; and WHEREAS, Only 7% of the national public school teaching 6 7 force is African-American; and 8 WHEREAS, The communities in this State where children live and learn are growing increasingly diverse; and 9 WHEREAS, In 2012, 49% of this State's 2,000,000 public 10 school students were racially and ethnically diverse, while 11 12 16.7% of this State's teachers were similarly diverse; and 13 WHEREAS, Providing targeted experiences and support to high school educators is essential 14 middle and in the recruitment and retention of a diverse teaching corps; and 15 16 WHEREAS, The Diversified Educator Recruitment Program will help support increasing the number of teacher candidates from 17 18 diverse populations; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-EIGHTH GENERAL
ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we urge the General
Assembly to fund the Diversified Educator Recruitment Program
to provide resources, support, and experiences to support the
recruitment and retention of racially diverse teacher
candidates.
