- 22 Section 55. The Public Community College Act is amended by

- 3 Sec. 3-29.11. Employment prohibition for Class X felony
- 4 conviction. A community college may not knowingly employ a
- person who has been convicted, after September 11, 2001, of 5
- attempting to commit, conspiring to commit, soliciting, or 6
- committing a Class X felony or any offense committed or 7
- 8 attempted in any other state or against the laws of the United
- 9 States that, if committed or attempted in this State, would
- 10 have been punishable as a Class X felony.
- Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon 11
- becoming law.". 12
