- 12 person as a professor or instructor who has been convicted,
- 13 after September 11, 2001, of attempting to commit, conspiring
- to commit, soliciting, or committing the offense of terrorism 14
- or any offense committed or attempted in any other state or 15
- against the laws of the United States that, if committed or 16
- 17 attempted in this State, would have been punishable as
- 18 terrorism.
- 19 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 20 becoming law.".
