4 Section 5. The Department of Public Health Powers and 5 Duties Law of the Civil Administrative Code of Illinois is 6 amended by adding Section 2310-685 as follows:

7 (20 ILCS 2310/2310-685 new)

- 8 Sec. 2310-685. Cytomegalovirus public education program.
- 9 (a) In this Section:
- 10 <u>"CMV" means cytomegalovirus.</u>
- 11 <u>"Health care provider" means any physician, hospital</u>
 12 <u>facility, or other person that is licensed or otherwise</u>
 13 authorized to deliver health care services.
- 14 (b) The Department shall develop or approve and publish 15 informational materials for women who may become pregnant.
- 15 <u>informational materials for women who may become pregnant</u>,
- 16 <u>expectant parents</u>, and parents of infants regarding:
- 17 (1) the incidence of CMV;

18 (2) the transmission of CMV to pregnant women and women 19 who may become pregnant;

- 20 (3) birth defects caused by congenital CMV;
- 21 (4) methods of diagnosing congenital CMV;
- 22 (5) available preventive measures to avoid the
 23 infection of women who are pregnant or may become pregnant;

2	(6) treatment options available for children born with
3	congenital CMV.
4	(c) The Department shall publish the information required
5	to be published under subsection (b) on its Internet website.
6	The Department may not charge a fee for physical copies of the
7	materials. The Department shall provide appropriate quantities
8	of the materials to any person upon request.
9	(d) The Department shall establish an outreach program to:
10	(1) educate women who may become pregnant, expectant
11	parents, and parents of infants about CMV; and
12	(2) raise awareness of CMV among health care providers
13	who provide care to expectant mothers or infants.
14	(e) The Department may solicit and accept the assistance of
15	any relevant medical associations or community resources,
16	including faith-based resources, to promote education about
17	CMV under this Section.
18	(f) If a newborn infant fails the 2 initial hearing
19	screenings in the hospital, then the hospital performing that
20	screening shall provide to the parents of the newborn infant
21	information regarding: (i) birth defects caused by congenital
22	CMV; (ii) testing opportunities and options for CMV, including
23	the opportunity to test for CMV before leaving the hospital;
24	and (iii) available early intervention services. The
25	Department shall develop or approve materials for parents
26	described in this subsection (d) and post the materials on its

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- website. Health care providers may use the materials developed
 by the Department.
- 3 (g) The Department shall adopt rules necessary to implement
- 4 <u>this Section</u>.
