SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

5 ILCS 490/127 new

Amends the State Commemorative Dates Act. Designates December 23 of each year as "Scott's Law Day" to honor public safety workers and to remind motorists to slow down, change lanes away from a stationary authorized emergency vehicle, and proceed with due regard to safety and traffic conditions.

- 8 designated as Scott's Law Day, to be observed throughout the
- 9 State as a day to honor public safety workers and to remind
- 10 motorists to slow down, change lanes away from a stationary
- 11 <u>authorized emergency vehicle</u>, and proceed with due regard to
- 12 safety and traffic conditions.
