2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend House Bill 494 as follows:

3 by replacing line 26 on page 2 through line 5 on page 3 with the  
4 following:

5 "determine if such applicants have been convicted of any of the  
6 enumerated criminal or drug offenses set forth in Section  
7 21B-80 ~~21-23a~~ of this Code within the delineated time frames  
8 or"; and

9 on page 3, line 6, by replacing "2 7" with "7"; and

10 by replacing line 24 on page 5 through line 3 of page 6 with the  
11 following:

12 "initiated or who has been convicted of any offense enumerated  
13 in Section 21B-80 of this Code within the delineated time  
14 frames or any"; and

1 on page 7, by replacing lines 14 through 17 with the following:  
2 "criminal or drug offenses in subsection (c) of this Section  
3 within the delineated time frames or have"; and

4 on page 7, line 18, by replacing "2 7" with "7"; and

5 on page 10, by replacing lines 22 through 26 with the  
6 following:

7 "criminal or drug offenses in subsection (c) within the  
8 delineated time frames or has not been convicted, within 7  
9 years of the application for"; and

10 on page 11, by replacing lines 12 through 16 with the  
11 following:

12 "not been convicted of any of the enumerated criminal or drug  
13 offenses in subsection (c) within the delineated time frames or  
14 has not been convicted, within 7"; and

15 on page 12, by replacing lines 12 through 18 with the  
16 following:

17 "been convicted of any offense that would subject him or her to  
18 license suspension or revocation pursuant to Section 21B-80 of  
19 this Code within the delineated time frames. Further, no school  
20 board shall"; and

21 on page 16, by replacing lines 1 and 2 with the following:

1           "Sec. 21B-80. Automatic disqualifying convictions for  
2 employment, licensure, and revocation of licensure ~~Conviction~~  
3 ~~of certain offenses as grounds for revocation of license.~~"; and

4           on page 16, line 18, after "Act", by inserting "Sections  
5 6-3.3 and 5-6-3.4 of the Unified Code of Corrections, or  
6 Article 40 of the Alcoholism and Other Drug Abuse and  
7 Dependency Act"; and

8           on page 16, line 25, after "Act", by inserting "or Article 40  
9 of the Alcoholism and Other Drug Abuse and Dependency Act"; and

10           on page 17, line 10, before "The changes", by inserting  
11 "Convictions under this definition are automatically  
12 disqualifying for a period of 5 years following the completion  
13 of the probationary sentence or release from incarceration,  
14 after which point the individual's conviction history is  
15 reviewable."; and

16           on page 17, by replacing line 15 with the following: "through  
17 11-9.5, inclusive, and 11-30 (if punished as a felony), of the  
18 Criminal Code"; and

19           on page 19, by replacing lines 14 through 18 with the  
20 following:

21 "convicted of any of the enumerated criminal or drug offenses

1 in subsection (c) of this Section within the delineated time  
2 frames or have been convicted, within 7 years"; and

3 on page 22, by replacing lines 21 through 24 with the  
4 following:

5 "criminal or drug offenses in subsection (c) within the  
6 delineated time frames or has not"; and

7 on page 23, by replacing lines 11 through 15 with the  
8 following:

9 "not been convicted of any of the enumerated criminal or drug  
10 offenses in subsection (c) within the delineated time frame or  
11 has not been convicted, within 7"; and

12 on page 24, by replacing lines 11 through 17 with the  
13 following:

14 "person who has been convicted of any offense that would  
15 subject him or her to license suspension or revocation pursuant  
16 to Section 21B-80 of this Code within the delineated time  
17 frames. Further,".
