Amends the Criminal Code of 2012. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning possession of explosives or explosive or incendiary devices.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Criminal Code of 2012 is amended by changing
- 5 Section 20-2 as follows:
- 6 (720 ILCS 5/20-2) (from Ch. 38, par. 20-2)
- Sec. 20-2. Possession of explosives or explosive or sincendiary devices.
- 9 (a) A person commits possession of explosives or explosive
  10 or incendiary devices in violation of this Section when he or
  11 she possesses, manufactures or transports any explosive
  12 compound, timing or detonating device for use with any
  13 explosive compound or incendiary device and and either intends
  14 to use the explosive or device to commit any offense or knows
  15 that another intends to use the explosive or device to commit a

- Possession of explosives or explosive or incendiary devices is a Class 1 felony for which a person, if sentenced to a term of imprisonment, shall be sentenced to not less than 4 years and not more than 30 years.
