### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

30 ILCS 500/45-20

Amends the Illinois Procurement Code. Provides that an otherwise qualified bidder or offeror who will fulfill the contract through the use of products made of recycled supplies shall (currently, may) be given a preference over bidders or offerors unable to do so, provided that the cost included in the bid of supplies is equal or less than other bids or offers. Effective immediately.

# 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Illinois Procurement Code is amended by 5 changing Section 45-20 as follows:

6 (30 ILCS 500/45-20)

7 Sec. 45-20. Recycled supplies. When a public contract is to be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder or offeror, an 8 9 otherwise qualified bidder or offeror who will fulfill the 10 contract through the use of products made of recycled supplies shall may be given preference over other bidders or offerors 11 unable to do so, provided that the cost included in the bid of 12 supplies is equal or less than other bids or offers made of 13 14 recycled materials does not constitute an undue economic or 15 practical hardship.
