1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 2568

2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend House Bill 2568, AS AMENDED, by  
3 replacing everything after the enacting clause with the  
4 following:

5 "Section 5. The Capital Development Board Act is amended by  
6 adding Section 19 as follows:

7 (20 ILCS 3105/19 new)

8 Sec. 19. Access to State building or construction codes.

9 (a) The Board shall maintain on its website, accessible  
10 from the Illinois State Government website, links to all  
11 currently applicable State building codes.

12 (b) Every State agency that proposes to adopt new building  
13 or construction requirements, or amendments to existing  
14 requirements, shall report that proposed activity to the Board.  
15 For purposes of this Section, State agency building or  
16 construction requirements include, but are not limited to,

1 those affecting general construction, plumbing, electrical,  
2 accessibility, fire protection, drinking water, waste water,  
3 asbestos, ozone, radon, and any other requirements that the  
4 State applies to construction activities. The report shall be  
5 submitted at least 30 days before the State agency officially  
6 proposes the changes by filing the First Notice of its  
7 rulemaking with the Secretary of State. The report shall  
8 include a plain language summary of the proposed changes and  
9 the State agency contact to whom comments on the proposal can  
10 be made.

11 (c) The Board shall provide on its website the information  
12 given to it by State agencies under subsection (b) and shall  
13 provide a link to the Illinois Register page where the  
14 rulemaking is proposed and can be viewed by the interested  
15 public.

16 (d) When the State agency moves its rulemaking to Second  
17 Notice, it shall notify the Board and the Board shall post a  
18 notice of this activity on its website and provide a link to  
19 the Illinois General Assembly website where the Second Notice  
20 version of the rulemaking can be viewed.

21 (e) When the State agency adopts a rulemaking creating or  
22 amending building or construction rules, it shall notify the  
23 Board and the Board shall post a notice of this activity on its  
24 website and provide a link to the Illinois Register page where  
25 the adoption occurred.

1           Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon  
2    becoming law.".
