10 Section 170. The amount of \$260,000, or so much thereof 11 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Used Tire 12 Management Fund to the Environmental Protection Agency for 13 the purposes as provided for in Section 55.6 of the 14 Environmental Protection Act.

15 Section 175. The amount of \$773,000, or so much thereof 16 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Underground 17 Storage Tank Fund to the Environmental Protection Agency for 18 case processing of leaking underground storage tank permit 19 and claims appeals.

Section 999. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,2015.
