SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

55 ILCS 5/6-1003

from Ch. 34, par. 6-1003

Amends the Counties Code. Provides that appropriations required to meet an immediate emergency and certain transfers of appropriations exceeding the budget may be made with a two-thirds vote of a county board. Effective immediately.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning local government.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Counties Code is amended by changing Section
5 6-1003 as follows:

6 (55 ILCS 5/6-1003) (from Ch. 34, par. 6-1003)

7 Sec. 6-1003. Further appropriations barred; transfers.
8 After the adoption of the county budget, no further
9 appropriations shall be made at any other time during such
10 fiscal year, except as provided in this Division.
11 Appropriations in excess of those authorized by the budget in
12 order to meet an immediate emergency may be made at any meeting
13 of the board by a two-thirds vote of all the members
14 constituting such board, the vote to be taken by ayes and nays
15 and entered on the record of the meeting. After the adoption of
16 the county budget, transfers of appropriations, other than
17 appropriations affecting personnel and capital ~~Transfers from~~
18 ~~one appropriation of any one fund to another of the same fund,~~
19 ~~not affecting the total amount appropriated,~~ may be made at any
20 meeting of the board by a two-thirds vote of all the members
21 constituting such board, the vote to be taken by ayes and nays
22 and entered on the record of the meeting, provided that the
23 total amount appropriated for the fund is not affected. ~~By a~~

1 ~~like vote the board may make appropriations in excess of those~~
