### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

305 ILCS 5/1-8.6 new

Amends the Illinois Public Aid Code. Provides that to the extent permitted by federal law and notwithstanding any other provision of the Code to the contrary, all persons incarcerated for at least 6 months at a county jail, juvenile detention center, or State correctional facility shall have their eligibility for medical assistance determined by the Department of Human Services prior to their release from custody. Grants the Department of Human Services rulemaking authority.

# 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Illinois Public Aid Code is amended by 5 adding Section 1-8.6 as follows:

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(305 ILCS 5/1-8.6 new)

7 Sec. 1-8.6. Incarcerated persons; medical assistance determinations. To the extent permitted by federal law and 8 9 notwithstanding any other provision of this Code to the contrary, all persons incarcerated for at least 6 months at a 10 county jail, juvenile detention center, or State correctional 11 12 facility shall have their eligibility for medical assistance determined by the Department of Human Services prior to their 13 14 release from custody. Counties, the Department of Juvenile Justice, the Department of Healthcare and Family Services, and 15 the Department of Corrections shall cooperate with the 16 17 Department of Human Services in implementing this Section. The Department of Human Services shall adopt any rules necessary to 18 19 implement this provision.
