1 AN ACT concerning education.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The College and Career Success for All Students

 Act is amended by adding Section 30 as follows:
- 6 (105 ILCS 302/30 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 30. Examination; postsecondary level course credit.</u>
- 8 (a) In this Section, "institution of higher education"
 9 means a public university or public community college located
- in this State.
- 11 (b) The Illinois Articulation Initiative, through its
- 12 <u>Major panels and General Education panels, shall review each of</u>
- 13 <u>the College Board Advanced Placement examinations and assign</u>
- 14 <u>codes for transfer. All courses, Advanced Placement or</u>
- otherwise, assigned codes for transfer through the Illinois
- 16 <u>Articulation Initiative must be guaranteed transfer credit as</u>
- 17 <u>an individual course and not be required to be part of a</u>
- 18 package of courses. The review must be completed within 6
- 19 <u>months after the effective date of this amendatory Act of the</u>
- 20 <u>99th General Assembly. Any review thereafter for any new or</u>
- 21 <u>substantially revised examinations must be completed within 6</u>
- 22 months after being released by the College Board.
- 23 <u>(c) Institutions of higher education that offer a</u>

- 1 corresponding course for a particular Advanced Placement examination are required to accept a student's score of 3 or 2 3 higher on the Advanced Placement examination for postsecondary 4 level course credit as a part of their general education degree requirements, if applicable, or for an elective credit if not. 5 6 If an institution of higher education does not offer a 7 corresponding course for a particular Advanced Placement examination, then the institution shall award, at a minimum, 8 9 elective postsecondary level course credit toward general 10 education degree requirements for those students who receive a 11 score of 3 or higher on the Advanced Placement examination.
- Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon 12 13 becoming law.
