SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

305 ILCS 5/12-4.13a new

Amends the Illinois Public Aid Code. Provides that subject to federal approval if required, a household that includes an elderly, blind, or disabled person shall be considered categorically eligible for Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) benefits if the gross income of such household is at or below 200% of the nonfarm income poverty guidelines updated periodically in the Federal Register by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services under the authority of 42 U.S.C. 9902(2); and a household that does not include an elderly, blind, or disabled person shall be considered categorically eligible for Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) benefits if the gross income of such household is at or below 165% of those nonfarm income poverty guidelines. Effective January 1, 2016.

Subject to federal approval if required, a household that 8 9 includes an elderly, blind, or disabled person shall be considered categorically eligible for Supplemental Nutrition 10 Assistance Program (SNAP) benefits if the gross income of such 11 12 household is at or below 200% of the nonfarm income poverty quidelines updated periodically in the Federal Register by the 13 14 U.S. Department of Health and Human Services under the authority of 42 U.S.C. 9902(2); and a household that does not 15 include an elderly, blind, or disabled person shall be 16 17 considered categorically eligible for Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) benefits if the gross income of such 18 19 household is at or below 165% of those nonfarm income poverty 20 guidelines.

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect January1, 2016.
