1 AN ACT concerning education.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Higher Education Student Assistance Act is amended by adding Section 65.90 as follows:
- 6 (110 ILCS 947/65.90 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 65.90. Medical assistant grants.</u>
- 8 (a) Beginning with the 2016-2017 academic year through the
 9 2020-2021 academic year, the Commission shall, each year,
 10 receive and consider applications for grant assistance under
 11 this Section. An applicant is eligible for a grant under this
- 12 <u>Section if the Commission finds that the applicant meets all of</u>
- the following qualifications:
- 14 <u>(1) He or she is a resident of this State and a United</u>
 15 States citizen or eligible noncitizen.
- 16 (2) He or she is enrolled or accepted for enrollment in

 17 a medical assistant program at a public community college

 18 in this State that will lead to certification to work as a

 19 medical assistant.
- 20 <u>(b) Recipients shall be selected from among applicants</u>
 21 <u>qualified pursuant to subsection (a) of this Section based on</u>
 22 <u>financial need, as determined by the Commission. Preference may</u>
 23 be given to previous recipients of assistance under this

- Section, provided they continue to maintain eligibility and 1
- 2 maintain satisfactory academic progress, as determined by the
- 3 institution at which they enroll.
- 4 (c) Each grant awarded under this Section shall be in an
- 5 amount sufficient to pay the tuition and fees of the
- institution at which the recipient is enrolled, except that no 6
- 7 recipient may receive more than \$5,000 in a single academic
- 8 year.
- 9 (d) The total amount of grant assistance awarded by the
- Commission under this Section to an individual in any given 10
- 11 fiscal year, when added to other financial assistance awarded
- 12 to that individual for that year, shall not exceed the cost of
- attendance at the institution at which the student is enrolled. 13
- 14 (e) All applications for grant assistance to be awarded
- 15 under this Section shall be made to the Commission in a form as
- 16 set forth by the Commission. The form of application and the
- 17 information required to be set forth in the application shall
- be determined by the Commission, and the Commission shall 18
- 19 require eligible applicants to submit with their applications
- 20 such supporting documents as the Commission deems necessary.
- 21 (f) Subject to a separate appropriation made for such
- 22 purposes, payment of any grants awarded under this Section
- 23 shall be determined by the Commission. All grant funds
- 24 distributed in accordance with this Section shall be paid to
- the institution on behalf of the recipients. Grant funds are 25
- applicable toward 2 semesters of enrollment within an academic 26

- 1 year. Up to 2% of the appropriation for this grant program may
- be used by the Commission for the costs of administering the 2
- 3 grant program.
- (g) The Commission shall administer the grant program 4
- 5 established by this Section and shall make all necessary and
- 6 proper rules not inconsistent with this Section for its
- 7 effective implementation.
