7 Section 5. The amount of \$119,900, or so much thereof as 8 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue 9 Fund to the Department of Human Services for costs associated 10 with the Illinois Welcoming Centers.

11 Section 10. The amount of \$482,800, or so much thereof as 12 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue 13 Fund to the Department of Human Services for costs associated 14 with Immigrant Integration Services and for other Immigrant Services pursuant to 305 ILCS 5/12-4.34, provided the agency 15 16 enters directly into agreements with grant recipients rather 17 than granting the funds to one agency serving as a fiscal 18 agent.
