

1 AN ACT making appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**  
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much  
6 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects  
7 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated from the  
8 General Revenue Fund to the Board of Higher Education to meet  
9 ordinary and contingent expenses for the fiscal year ending  
10 June 30, 2016:

1           Section 10. The sum of \$83,800, or so much thereof as may  
 2           be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund  
 3           to the Board of Higher Education for costs and expenses  
 4           associated with the administration and enforcement associated  
 5           with the P-20 Longitudinal Education Data System Act.

6           Section 15. The sum of \$193,500, or so much thereof as  
 7           may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
 8           Fund to the Board of Higher Education for costs associated  
 9           with MyCreditsTransfer.

10          Section 20. The following named amount, or so much  
 11          thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General  
 12          Revenue Fund to the Board of Higher Education for  
 13          distribution as grants authorized by the Higher Education  
 14          Cooperation Act:

16          Section 25. The following named sums, or so much thereof

6 Section 30. The sum of \$1,034,900, or so much thereof as  
7 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
8 Fund to the Board of Higher Education for distribution as  
9 grants for Cooperative Work Study Programs to institutions of  
10 higher education.

11 Section 35. The sum of \$1,114,400, or so much thereof as  
12 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
13 Fund to the Board of Higher Education for a grant to the  
14 Board of Trustees of the University Center of Lake County for  
15 the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Center.

16 Section 40. The sum of \$1,383,700, or so much thereof as  
17 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
18 Fund to the Board of Higher Education for the administration  
19 and distribution of grants authorized by the Diversifying  
20 Higher Education Faculty in Illinois Program.

21 Section 45. The sum of \$1,466,300, or so much thereof as

1 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
2 Fund to the Illinois Board of Higher Education for the Grow  
3 Your Own Teachers Program.

4 Section 50. The sum of \$394,600, or so much thereof as  
5 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
6 Fund to the Board of Higher Education for competitive grants  
7 for nursing schools to increase the number of graduating  
8 nurses.

9 Section 55. The sum of \$208,300, or so much thereof as  
10 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
11 Fund to the Board of Higher Education for nurse educator  
12 fellowships to supplement nurse faculty salaries.

13 Section 60. The sum of \$93,000, or so much thereof as may  
14 be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund  
15 to the Board of Higher Education for the Washington Center  
16 Intern Program.

17 Section 65. The amount of \$400,000, or so much thereof as  
18 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Academic Quality  
19 Assurance Fund to the Board of Higher Education as  
20 supplemental support for costs and expenses associated with  
21 the administration and enforcement of 110 ILCS 1010.

1           Section 70. The amount of \$80,000, or so much thereof as  
2           may be necessary, is appropriated from the Private College  
3           Academic Quality Assurance Fund to the Board of Higher  
4           Education as supplemental support for costs and expenses  
5           associated with the administration and enforcement of 110  
6           ILCS 1005.

7           Section 75. The amount of \$550,000, or so much thereof as  
8           may be necessary, is appropriated from the Private Business  
9           and Vocational Schools Quality Assurance Fund to the Board of  
10          Higher Education as supplemental support for costs and  
11          expenses associated with the administration and enforcement  
12          of the Private Business and Vocational Schools Act of 2012.

13          Section 80. The sum of \$5,500,000, or so much thereof as  
14          may be necessary, is appropriated from the BHE Federal Grants  
15          Fund to the Board of Higher Education to be expended under  
16          the terms and conditions associated with the federal  
17          contracts and grants moneys received.

18          Section 85. The following named amounts, or so much  
19          thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects  
20          and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated from the  
21          Education Assistance Fund to the Illinois Mathematics and

1 Science Academy to meet ordinary and contingent expenses for  
2 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016:

 12 to the Board of Higher Education as supplemental support for  
 13 costs and expenses associated with the administration and  
 14 enforcement of 110 ILCS 145/40.

15 ARTICLE 2

16 Section 5. The sum of \$185,426,500 or so much thereof as  
 17 may be necessary is appropriated from the Education  
 18 Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of Southern Illinois  
 19 University for ordinary and contingent expenses for the  
 20 fiscal year ending June 30, 2016.

21  
 22 Section 10. The sum of \$1,173,000, or so much thereof as

1 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education  
2 Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of Southern Illinois  
3 University for all costs associated with the SimmonsCooper  
4 Cancer Center.

5 Section 15. The sum of \$27,000, or so much thereof as  
6 may be necessary, is appropriated from the State College and  
7 University Trust Fund to the Board of Trustees of Southern  
8 Illinois University for scholarship grant awards, in  
9 accordance with Public Act 91-0083.

10 Section 20. The sum of \$1,250,000, or so much thereof as  
11 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General  
12 Professions Dedicated Fund to the Board of Trustees of  
13 Southern Illinois University for all costs associated with  
14 the development, support or administration of pharmacy  
15 practice education or training programs at the Edwardsville  
16 campus.

17 Section 25. The sum of \$64,000, or so much thereof as  
18 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
19 Fund to the Southern Illinois University for any costs  
20 associated with the Daily Egyptian newspaper.

21 Section 30. The sum of \$311,000, or so much thereof as



1 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention  
 2 Fund to the Board of Trustees of Southern Illinois University  
 3 for costs associated with fire protection services at the  
 4 Southern Illinois University Edwardsville campus.

5 ARTICLE 3

6 Section 1. The sum of \$545,127,300 or so much thereof as  
 7 may be necessary is appropriated from the Education  
 8 Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of University of  
 9 Illinois for ordinary and contingent expenses for the fiscal  
 10 year ending June 30, 2016.

11 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much  
 12 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects  
 13 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated to the Board  
 14 of Trustees of the University of Illinois to meet ordinary  
 15 and contingent expenses for the fiscal year ending June 30,  
 16 2016:

1           Section 10. The sum of \$15,378,800, or so much thereof  
2 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
3 Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of Illinois  
4 for costs and expenses related to or in support of the  
5 Prairie Research Institute, in accordance with Public Act 95-  
6 0728.

7           Section 15. The sum of \$41,128,300, or so much thereof  
8 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
9 Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of Illinois  
10 for operating costs and expenses related to or in support of  
11 the University of Illinois Hospital.

12           Section 20. The sum of \$686,300, or so much thereof as  
13 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education  
14 Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of  
15 Illinois for costs associated with the Hispanic Center for  
16 Excellence at the Chicago campus.

17           Section 25. The sum of \$281,700, or so much thereof as  
18 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education  
19 Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of  
20 Illinois for Dixon Springs Agricultural Center.

1 Section 30. The sum of \$1,072,300, or so much thereof as  
2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education  
3 Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of  
4 Illinois for costs associated with the Public Policy  
5 Institute at the Chicago campus.

6 Section 35. The sum of \$300,200, or so much thereof as  
7 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education  
8 Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of  
9 Illinois for a grant to the College of Dentistry.

10 Section 40. The sum of \$3,816,200, or so much thereof as  
11 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention  
12 Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of Illinois  
13 for the purpose of maintaining the Illinois Fire Service  
14 Institute, paying the Institute's expenses, and providing the  
15 facilities and structures incident thereto, including payment  
16 to the University for personal services and related costs  
17 incurred.

18 Section 45. The sum of \$250,000, or so much thereof as  
19 may be necessary, is appropriated from the State College and  
20 University Trust Fund to the Board of Trustees of the  
21 University of Illinois for scholarship grant awards, in  
22 accordance with Public Act 91-0083.

1           Section 50. The sum of \$200,000, or so much thereof as  
2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Emergency Public  
3 Health Fund to the University of Illinois for costs and  
4 expenses related to or in support of Emergency Mosquito  
5 Abatement.

6           Section 55. The sum of \$200,000, or so much thereof as  
7 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Used Tire  
8 Management Fund to the University of Illinois for costs and  
9 expenses related to or in support of mosquito research and  
10 abatement.

11          Section 60. The sum of \$500,000, or so much thereof as  
12 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Hazardous Waste  
13 Research Fund to the University of Illinois for its ordinary  
14 and contingent expenses.

15          Section 65. The sum of \$500,000, or so much thereof as  
16 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General  
17 Professions Dedicated Fund to the Board of Trustees of the  
18 University of Illinois for costs associated with the  
19 development, support or administration of pharmacy practice  
20 education or training programs for the College of Medicine at  
21 Rockford.
