1 AN ACT making appropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

4 ARTICLE 1

Section 5. The sum of \$12,612,600, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Department of Human Services for grants and administrative expenses associated with the Department's rebalancing efforts pursuant to 20 ILCS 1305/1-50 and in support of the Department's efforts to expand home and community-based services, including rebalancing and transition costs associated with compliance with consent decrees.

Section 10. The following named sums, or so much thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated to the Department of Human Services for Grants-In-Aid and Purchased Care in its various regions pursuant to Sections 3 and 4 of the Community Services Act and the Community Mental Health Act:
