## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Makes appropriations to the Department of Transportation from the Motor Fuel Tax Fund for specified payments to local governments. Makes appropriations to the Illinois Gaming Board from the State Gaming Fund for distributions to local governments for admissions and wager tax, including prior year costs. Makes appropriations to the Department of the Lottery from the State Lottery Fund for payment of prizes to holders of winning lottery tickets or shares, including prizes related to Multi-State Lottery games, and payment of promotional or incentive prizes associated with the sale of lottery tickets. Makes appropriations from the Wireless Service Emergency Fund and the Statewide 9-1-1 Fund to the of State Police for the Statewide Department Administrator Program and for costs pursuant to the Emergency Telephone System Act, respectively. Makes appropriations from the Wireless Service Emergency Fund to the Illinois Commerce for specified emergency telecommunications purposes. Effective immediately.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

4	Section 5. The following named sums, or so much thereof
5	as are available for distribution in accordance with Section
6	8 of the Motor Fuel Tax Law, are appropriated from the Motor
7	Fuel Tax Fund to the Department of Transportation for the
8	purposes stated:

17	Section 10. The sum of \$100,000,000, or so much thereof
18	as may be necessary, is appropriated from the State Gaming
19	Fund to the Illinois Gaming Board for distributions to local

- Section 15. The sum of \$1,000,000,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the State Lottery Fund to the Department of the Lottery for payment of prizes to holders of winning lottery tickets or shares, including prizes related to Multi-State Lottery games, and payment of promotional or incentive prizes associated with the sale of lottery tickets, pursuant to the provisions of the Illinois
- 9 Section 20. The sum of \$2,013,600, or so much thereof as
  10 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Department of State
  11 Police, Division of Administration, from the Wireless Service
  12 Emergency Fund for expenses incurred for the Statewide 911
  13 Administrator Program.
- Section 25. The sum of \$75,000,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Statewide 9-1-1 Fund to the Department of State Police for costs pursuant to the Emergency Telephone System Act.
- Section 30. The sum of \$77,130,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Wireless Service Emergency Fund to the Illinois Commerce Commission for its administrative costs and for grants to emergency telephone system boards, qualified government entities, or

- 2 implementation, operation, maintenance, or upgrade of
- 3 wireless 9-1-1 or E9-1-1 emergency services and public safety

- 5 Section 98. The appropriation authority granted in this
- 6 Act shall be valid for costs incurred July 1, 2015 through
- 7 June 30, 2016.
- 8 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 9 becoming law.
