

# HB4305 Engrossed



1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**  
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The following named sums, or so much thereof  
6 as are available for distribution in accordance with Section 8  
7 of the Motor Fuel Tax Law, are appropriated from the Motor Fuel  
8 Tax Fund to the Department of Transportation for the purposes  
9 stated:

10 DISTRIBUTIVE ITEMS

11 For apportioning, allotting, and paying  
12 as provided by law:

13	To Counties.....	204,108,000
14	To Municipalities.....	285,775,000
15	To Counties for Distribution to	
16	Road Districts.....	<u>92,617,000</u>
17	Total	\$582,500,000

18 Section 10. The sum of \$100,000,000, or so much thereof  
19 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the State Gaming Fund  
20 to the Illinois Gaming Board for distributions to local  
21 governments for admissions and wagering tax, including prior

1 year costs.

2 Section 15. The sum of \$1,000,000,000, or so much thereof  
3 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the State Lottery  
4 Fund to the Department of the Lottery for payment of prizes to  
5 holders of winning lottery tickets or shares, including prizes  
6 related to Multi-State Lottery games, and payment of  
7 promotional or incentive prizes associated with the sale of  
8 lottery tickets, pursuant to the provisions of the Illinois  
9 Lottery Law.

10 Section 20. The sum of \$2,013,600, or so much thereof as  
11 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Department of State  
12 Police, Division of Administration, from the Wireless Service  
13 Emergency Fund for expenses incurred for the Statewide 911  
14 Administrator Program.

15 Section 25. The sum of \$75,000,000, or so much thereof  
16 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Statewide 9-1-1  
17 Fund to the Department of State Police for costs pursuant to  
18 the Emergency Telephone System Act.

19 Section 30. The sum of \$77,130,000, or so much thereof  
20 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Wireless Service  
21 Emergency Fund to the Illinois Commerce Commission for its

1 administrative costs and for grants to emergency telephone  
 2 system boards, qualified government entities, or the Department  
 3 of State Police for the design, implementation, operation,  
 4 maintenance, or upgrade of wireless 9-1-1 or E9-1-1 emergency  
 5 services and public safety answering points.

6 Section 35. The following named sums, or so much thereof  
 7 as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects and purposes  
 8 hereinafter named, are appropriated to meet the ordinary and  
 9 contingent expenses of the Department of Revenue:

10 GOVERNMENT SERVICES

11 PAYABLE FROM LOCAL GOVERNMENT VIDEO GAMING

12 DISTRIBUTIVE FUND

13 For allocation to local governments  
 14 of the net terminal income tax per  
 15 the Video Gaming Act.....45,000,000

16 PAYABLE FROM STATE AND LOCAL SALES TAX REFORM FUND

17 For allocation to Chicago for additional  
 18 1.25% Use Tax pursuant to P.A. 86-0928.....84,400,000

19 PAYABLE FROM LOCAL GOVERNMENT DISTRIBUTIVE FUND

20 For allocation to local governments  
 21 for additional 1.25% Use Tax  
 22 pursuant to P.A. 86-0928.....255,100,000

23 Section 40. The following named sums, or so much thereof

1 as may be necessary, are appropriated to the Department of  
2 Public Health for the objects and purposes hereinafter named:

3 OFFICE OF HEALTH PROMOTION

4 Payable from the Multiple Sclerosis Research Fund:

5 For grants to conduct Multiple

6 Sclerosis research.....3,000,000

7 Section 45. The following named sums, or so much thereof  
8 as may be necessary, are appropriated to the Department of  
9 Public Health for expenses of programs related to Acquired  
10 Immunodeficiency Syndrome (AIDS) and Human Immunodeficiency  
11 Virus (HIV):

12 OFFICE OF HEALTH PROTECTION: AIDS/HIV

13 Payable from the Quality of Life Endowment Fund:

14 For grants and expenses associated

15 with HIV/AIDS prevention and education.....2,000,000

16 Section 50. The following named amounts, or so much  
17 thereof as may be necessary, are appropriated to the Department  
18 of Public Health for the objects and purposes hereinafter  
19 named:

20 OFFICE OF WOMEN'S HEALTH

21 Payable from the Carolyn Adams Ticket

22 for the Cure Grant Fund:

23 For Grants and related expenses to

1 public or private entities in Illinois  
 2 for the purpose of funding research  
 3 concerning breast cancer and for  
 4 funding services for breast cancer victims.....2,500,000

5 Section 55. The following named sums, or so much thereof  
 6 as may be necessary, respectively, for the purposes hereinafter  
 7 named, are appropriated to the Department of Human Services for  
 8 Grants-In-Aid and Purchased Care in its various regions  
 9 pursuant to Sections 3 and 4 of the Community Services Act and  
 10 the Community Mental Health Act:

11 DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES GRANTS AND PROGRAM SUPPORT

12 GRANTS-IN-AID AND PURCHASED CARE

13 Payable from Special Olympics Illinois and  
 14 Special Children's Charities Fund:  
 15 For grants to Special Olympics  
 16 Illinois and Special Children's Charities.....700,000

17 Section 60. The sum of \$8,300,000, or so much thereof as  
 18 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Veterans  
 19 Assistance Fund to the Department of Veterans' Affairs for  
 20 making grants, funding additional services, or conducting  
 21 additional research projects relating to veterans' post  
 22 traumatic stress disorder; veterans' homelessness; the health  
 23 insurance cost of veterans; veterans' disability benefits,

1 including but not limited to, disability benefits provided by  
 2 veterans service organizations and veterans assistance  
 3 commissions or centers; and the long-term care of veterans.

4 Section 65. The following named amounts, or so much  
 5 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects and  
 6 purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated from the IMSA  
 7 Income Fund to the Illinois Mathematics and Science Academy to  
 8 meet ordinary and contingent expenses for the fiscal year  
 9 ending June 30, 2016:

10	For Personal Services.....	2,261,900
11	For State Contributions to Social	
12	Security, for Medicare.....	45,900
13	For Contractual Services.....	294,700

22 Section 70. The following named amounts, or so much  
 23 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated for

1 the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Office of the State  
2 Fire Marshal, as follows:

3 GRANTS

4 Payable from the Fire Prevention Fund:

5 For Chicago Fire Department Training Program.....2,544,200

6 For payment to local governmental agencies

7 which participate in the State Training

8 Programs.....950,000

9 Total \$3,494,200

10 Section 75. The sum of \$125,000, or so much thereof as  
11 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention Fund  
12 to the Office of the State Fire Marshal for grants available  
13 for costs and services related to ILEAS/MABAS administration.

14 Section 80. The sum of \$3,816,200, or so much thereof as  
15 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention Fund  
16 to the Board of Trustees of the University of Illinois for the  
17 purpose of maintaining the Illinois Fire Service Institute,  
18 paying the Institute's expenses, and providing the facilities  
19 and structures incident thereto, including payment to the  
20 University for personal services and related costs incurred.

21 Section 85. The following named amount, or so much  
22 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects and



1 purposes hereinafter named, is appropriated to the Law  
2 Enforcement Training Standards Board as follows:

3 GRANTS-IN-AID

4 Payable from the Traffic and Criminal  
5 Conviction Surcharge Fund:

6 For payment of and/or reimbursement  
7 of training and training services  
8 in accordance with statutory provisions.....12,000,000

9 Section 90. The following named amounts, or so much  
10 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects and  
11 purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated to the Illinois  
12 Criminal Justice Information Authority for the training of law  
13 enforcement personnel and services for families of victims of  
14 homicide or murder:

15 Payable from the Death Penalty Abolition Fund:

16 For Awards and Grants to State Agencies  
17 for training of law enforcement personnel  
18 and services for families of victims of  
19 homicide or murder.....5,000,000

20 ARTICLE 998

21 Section 5. The appropriation authority granted in this  
22 Act shall be valid for costs incurred July 1, 2015 through June

1 30, 2016.

2 ARTICLE 999

3 Section 999. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon  
4 becoming law.
