SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Makes appropriations from non-general revenue funds as provided by law. With respect to Funds where no distributions are provided for by law, and from which distributions were made, in whole or part, during Fiscal Year 2015 through appropriations, provides that, if no such appropriation has been enacted in Fiscal Year 2016, then appropriations shall be made for Fiscal Year 2016 in the same manner as provided for Fiscal Year 2015. Effective immediately.

AN ACT concerning appropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented 2 in the General Assembly: 3

4 Section 5. FY16 Non-General Revenue Fund Appropriations. This Section shall not apply to the General Revenue Fund. 5 With respect to moneys received by any Fund in the State 6 7 treasury, or any Fund held outside of the State treasury the 8 distribution of which is provided for by law, the full amount 9 received, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby 10 appropriated and shall be distributed in the manner provided 11 by law for that Fund. For those Funds that distribute moneys 12 received from non-State sources, the full amount received 13 from non-State sources, or so much thereof as may be 14 necessary, is hereby appropriated and shall be distributed in 15 the manner provided by law for that Fund, without regard to 16 the amount of moneys received. For those Funds where no 17 distributions are provided for by law, and from which 18 distributions were made, in whole or part, during Fiscal Year 19 2015 through appropriations, if no such appropriation has been enacted in Fiscal Year 2016, then appropriations shall 20 21 be made for Fiscal Year 2016 in the same manner as provided 22 for Fiscal Year 2015.
