- 8 (a) As used in this Section, "mobilization payment" means
  9 an advance payment to a contractor or subcontractor that
  10 enables the contractor or subcontractor to purchase necessary
  11 machinery and tools for a project. "Mobilization payment" may
  12 also include other goods or services necessary for a project
- 14 <u>(b) All contracts under this Code entered into by the</u>
  15 <u>Department of Transportation shall provide for mobilization</u>
  16 payments unless explicitly rejected by the contractor.

when expressly provided for within the contract.

- 17 <u>(c) When a contract under this Code entered into by the</u>
  18 <u>Department of Transportation provides for mobilization</u>
  19 <u>payments and the contractor is using the services of a</u>
  20 <u>subcontractor, the subcontract shall include terms requiring</u>
  21 mobilization payments be made to the subcontractor.
