## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

The program shall provide assistance, subject to appropriation, to eligible <u>physicians</u> <u>and</u> nurses.

(a) The Commission shall, on an annual basis, receive and
 consider applications for grant assistance under the program.
 An applicant is eligible for a grant under the program if the

(2) is a resident of Illinois;

(b) Preference may be given to previous recipients of a

(c) For each year during which an individual receives a grant under this program, he or she must fulfill a separate 12-month period as a <u>physician, certified nurse practitioner</u>, registered professional nurse, <u>certified nursing assistant</u>, or licensed practical nurse in a State veterans' home.
