**A BILL FOR**

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**  
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 1. The following named amounts, or so much  
6 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated  
7 to the Human Rights Commission for the objects and purposes  
8 hereinafter enumerated:

9 GENERAL OFFICE

10 Payable from General Revenue Fund:

11	For Personal Services .....	1,617,100
12	For State Contributions to Social Security .....	123,700
13	For Contractual Services .....	120,800
14	For Travel .....	6,100
15	For Commodities .....	6,500
16	For Printing .....	1,900
17	For Equipment .....	4,900
18	For Electronic Data Processing .....	30,500
19	For Telecommunications Services .....	<u>16,900</u>
20	Total	\$1,928,400

21 Section 5. The sum of \$293,300, or so much thereof as

1     may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
2     Fund to the Human Rights Commission for the Illinois Torture  
3     Inquiry Relief Commission.

4             Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July  
5     1, 2016, if and only if Senate Bill 2789 of the 99<sup>th</sup> General  
6     Assembly (the Unbalanced Budget Response Act), as introduced  
7     in the Illinois Senate, becomes law.
