

# 99TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2015 and 2016 HB6581

Introduced , by Rep. Jim Durkin

### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Makes appropriations to various State agencies and the Office of the Governor for specified purposes. Amends Public Act 99-491 by changing the amounts of certain appropriations. Makes a reappropriation from the Capital Development Fund to the Capital Development Board. If and only if Senate Bill 2038 of the 99th General Assembly becomes law, repeals a provision in Senate Bill 2038 limiting the appropriation authority granted in that bill. Effective immediately.

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1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

4 ARTICLE 1

Section 1. The amount of \$36,000,000, or so much thereof
as may be necessary, is appropriated from the State Garage
Revolving Fund to the Department of Central Management
Services to meet the ordinary and contingent expenses of the
Department of Central Management Services, not including
personal services.

Section 5. The amount of \$30,000,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Statistical Services Revolving Fund to the Department of Central Management Services to meet the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Department of Central Management Services, not including personal services.

17 ARTICLE 2

Section 1. "An Act concerning appropriations", Public

Act 99-491, approved December 7, 2015, is amended by changing

- as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Working Capital
- 21 Revolving Fund to the Department of Corrections for ordinary

- 1 and contingent expenses, but not including personal services.
- 2 Section 10. The amount of \$150,000,000, or so much
- 3 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Budget
- 4 Stabilization Fund to the Department of Corrections for
- 5 ordinary and contingent expenses, but not including personal
- 6 services.
- 7 ARTICLE 4
- 8 Section 1. The sum of \$25,000,000, or so much thereof as
- 9 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Department of Human
- 10 Services from the Budget Stabilization Fund for operational
- 11 expenses, but not including personal services.
- 12 ARTICLE 5
- 13 Section 1. The amount of \$100,000,000, or so much
- 14 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Budget
- 15 Stabilization Fund to the Office of the Governor to be
- 16 directed to the state agencies to be expended, in the
- discretion of and as determined by the Governor upon written
- 18 direction of the Governor to the Comptroller, for operational
- 19 expenses, but not including personal services.

#### 6 ARTICLE 10

7 Section 1. The sum of \$38,660,816, or so much thereof as may be necessary and remains unexpended at the close of 8 9 business on June 30, 2015, from a reappropriation heretofore made for such purpose in Article 14, Section 350 of Public 10 11 Act 98-0675, is reappropriated from the Capital Development 12 Fund to the Capital Development Board for use by the State, 13 departments, authorities, public its corporations, 14 commissions and agencies as authorized by subsection (e) of 15 Section 3 of the General Obligation Bond Act.

#### 16 ARTICLE 11

Section 1. The following named amounts, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are appropriated to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency for the objects and purposes hereinafter named:

#### DISASTER ASSISTANCE AND PREPAREDNESS

- 4 for expenses attributable to implementation
- 5 and maintenance of plans and programs
- 6 authorized by the Nuclear Safety

- 8 Section 15. The sum of \$2,624,000, or so much thereof as
- 9 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Radiation
- 10 Protection Fund to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency
- 11 for the ordinary and contingent expenses, but not including
- 12 personal services, incurred by the Illinois Emergency
- 13 Management Agency.
- Section 25. The sum of \$5,648,600, or so much thereof as
- may be necessary, is appropriated from the Nuclear Safety
- 16 Emergency Preparedness Fund to the Illinois Emergency
- 17 Management Agency for the ordinary and contingent expenses,
- but not including personal services, incurred by the Illinois
- 19 Emergency Management Agency.
- 20 Section 30. The sum of \$12,000,000, or so much thereof
- 21 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Disaster
- 22 Response and Recovery Fund to the Illinois Emergency

- 1 Management Agency for all current and prior year expenses
- 2 associated with disaster response and recovery.
- 3 ARTICLE 90
- 4 (S.B. 2038, 99th G.A., Article 996 rep.)
- 5 Section 1. If and only if Senate Bill 2038 of the 99th
- 6 General Assembly becomes law, then "An Act concerning
- 7 appropriations" (Senate Bill 2038 of the 99th General
- 8 Assembly) is amended by repealing Article 996.
- 9 ARTICLE 99
- 10 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 11 becoming law.
