HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Tens of millions of Americans are affected by 2 3 bladder diseases and conditions, including urinarv 4 incontinence, overactive bladder, underactive bladder, 5 interstitial cystitis, nocturia, urinary tract infections, 6 bladder cancer, urotrauma, and neurogenic bladder; and

7 WHEREAS, Bladder diseases and conditions have significant 8 impact on health and quality of life, contributing to 9 depression, social isolation, falls, sexual dysfunction, loss 10 of self-esteem, hospitalizations, nursing home admissions, and 11 even death; and

12 WHEREAS, Medical and behavioral research to better 13 understand and maintain bladder health and treat bladder 14 diseases is critically needed, yet poorly recognized; and

15 WHEREAS, Bladder problems are highly stigmatized; open 16 dialogue generated by the designation of a Bladder Health Month 17 can reduce stigma and empower providers and patients to have 18 much-needed conversations about bladder health; therefore, be 19 it
