18 WHEREAS, Lorene King has been the Assistant Director of
19 Student Development and most recently the Outreach and
20 Recruitment Coordinator with the Peoria College of Medicine
21 Urban Health Program for the past nine years; during this time,
22 she provided enhanced support to students from
23 underrepresented populations and dedicated substantial

2 experiencing academic difficulties; she also played an
3 instrumental part in connecting medical students with the local
4 community to perform volunteer service projects and
5 strengthened the UICOMP presence within underserved
6 communities; and
