

1 AN ACT concerning health.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 1. Short title. This Act may be cited as the
5 Lactation Accommodation in Airports Act.

6 Section 5. Private place for nursing mothers.

7 (a) On or before January 1, 2017, the airport manager of an
8 airport operated by a city, county, city and county, or airport
9 district that conducts commercial operations and that has more
10 than 1,000,000 enplanements a year shall provide a room or
11 other location at each airport terminal behind the airport
12 security screening area for members of the public to express
13 breast milk in private that:

14 (1) includes, at a minimum, a chair and an electrical
15 outlet; and

16 (2) is located outside of the confines of a public
17 restroom.

18 (b) An airport that conducts commercial operations with
19 fewer than 1,000,000 enplanements a year shall comply with
20 subsections (a) and (c) of this Section upon new terminal
21 construction or the replacement, expansion, or renovation of an
22 existing terminal.

23 (c) Upon construction of a new terminal or the replacement,

1 expansion, or renovation of an existing terminal, an airport
2 shall provide a sink in any room or other location designated
3 to comply with this Section.

4 (d) As used in this Section, "renovation of an existing
5 terminal" means the repurposing of more than 25% of the space
6 in the terminal.

7 Section 90. The State Mandates Act is amended by adding
8 Section 8.39 as follows:

9 (30 ILCS 805/8.39 new)

10 Sec. 8.39. Exempt mandate. Notwithstanding Sections 6 and 8
11 of this Act, no reimbursement by the State is required for the
12 implementation of any mandate created by this amendatory Act of
13 the 99th General Assembly.
