AN ACT concerning local government.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Water Commission Act of 1985 is amended by 5 changing Section 2.1 as follows:

Sec. 2.1. Cessation of commission organization.

(a) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, if a 8 9 majority vote of the water commission is in favor of the proposition to annex the commission to another commission whose 10 boundaries are contiguous, or consolidate the commission into a 11 municipality with which the commission is coterminous or 12 13 substantially coterminous, or consolidate the commission into 14 the county in which the commission sits, and if the governing authorities of the governmental unit assuming the functions of 15 the former commission agree by resolution to accept the 16 17 functions (and jurisdiction over the territory, if applicable) of the consolidated or annexed commission, then the commission 18 19 shall cease. On the effective date of the annexation or duties, 20 consolidation, all the rights, powers, assets, 21 property, liabilities, indebtedness, obligations, bonding 22 authority, taxing authority, and responsibilities of the commission shall vest in and be assumed by the governmental 23

1 unit assuming the functions of the former commission.

2 The employees of the former commission shall be transferred to the governmental unit assuming the functions of the former 3 commission. The governmental unit assuming the functions of the 4 5 former commission shall exercise the rights and 6 responsibilities of the former commission with respect to those 7 employees. The status and rights of the employees of the former 8 commission under any applicable contracts or collective 9 bargaining agreements, historical representation rights under 10 the Illinois Public Labor Relations Act, or under any pension, 11 retirement, or annuity plan shall not be affected by this 12 amendatory Act.

(b) This Section shall not apply to any water commission
organized in DuPage County.
